

## Kadel wins tourney

Doris Kadel of Elks Country Club edged out Elise Friend of Lochland to become the new Hastings Women's Golf Association Tournament champion.

Both women tied with 43s on their qualifying rounds at Elks. In the semi-final round at Lochland Kadel shot an 18-hole total of 91 and Friend shot an 18-hole total of 95 giving Kadel a 4-shot advantage.

In the final round at Southern Hills Kadel shot an 18-hole total of 84 giving her a three-day total of 218. Friend shot an 18-hole total of 95 giving her a three-day total of 233.

Friend had a front nine total of 42 to break the qualifying round tie to win the medalist award. In third place in the

championship flight was Ruth Svoboda with a three-day total of 238.

Winning the president's flight with a 253 was Jan Fricke of Southern Hills. One stroke back for second place was Barb Miller of Lochland. Third with a 259 was Irma Nejschleb of Southern Hills.

There was a tie for first place in the first flight between Erma Cummings and Pam Meyer, both of Southern Hills, with a three-day total of 159. Third place was Norma Boyer of Lochland with a 163. Rounding out the nine hole division, winning the second flight, was Karen Tegler, Southern Hills, with a three-day total of 169. In the fourth flight the winner was Flossie Uhrmacher, Southern Hills, with a 185.
