WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO PLAY GOLF DURING PROJECT EMERALD?

Lochland Country Club has made arrangements with several Nebraska golf courses that will be happy to host our members (most are giving a discount) during Project Emerald. Please see listing at left. In particular, the members and Board of Riverside Golf Club have made special arrangements for Lochland members to play at RGC.

Lochland will pay guest fees for
Lochland members playing at
Riverside from August 1, 2015
through November 30, 2015; however,
Lochland members will have to
pay for their own carts, range balls,
and non-Lochland guests.

DRESS CODES at OTHER COURSES

It is always better to error on the side of caution when playing at a private club that is not your home club. Both men and women will always be safe wearing collared golf shirts, tucked in, and khaki pants, skirts or Bermuda-type shorts. Please stay away from cargo shorts. Most clubs do not allow denim, so make sure to have rain pants available as the weather turns cooler.

MAKING TEE TIMES for RIVERSIDE GOLF CLUB

In order to make a tee time, call the Lochland Country Club Golf Shop with the names, date and time you would like to play, and our golf professional will make the tee time for you. Due to a previous problem with Lochland members not showing up for tee times during the Pepsi weekend, Lochland members may only make 1 tee time per member...1 person may not make multiple tee times for a group of more than 4 players. For example, if 8 of you are hoping to play in 2 groups back-to-back, 1 member will need to call in for the first group, and another member will need to call in for the second group. Please communicate thoroughly with your group to make certain who will or will not be present. Riverside is a very busy golfing club, so it is imperative that your groups communicate with each other to make sure who is playing. If there is a cancellation in your group, RGC must be contacted within 24 hours or the "captain" of the tee time will be charged a guest fee to his/her account (Lochland CC will not pay for no-shows). In addition, Riverside reserves the right to pair individuals with your group if you have less than a 4-some.

MAKING TEE TIMES at OTHER NEBRASKA COURSES

Similar to the process being used for Riverside, call the Lochland Country Club Golf Shop with the date, range of time and names of individuals in your group and which golf course you would like to play. We have 17 golf courses lined up (see list at left), but each golf course has its own day/ date restrictions. You may need to be flexible with your tee time request, as we are at the mercy of the other clubs' activities. As an example, you may want to play at Course "X" on Thursday, September 3rd at 1PM. Course "X" may have league on that night, so you may have to play at 12:30PM. Just be aware that the exact tee time you desire may not be available, and our golf professional will make one as close as possible to the time you requested, unless the difference is more than 1 hour. In addition, the golf professional will let you know of any dress code or other restrictions at the course you wish to play.

As mentioned before, some of these courses are offering discounts, some are not. Each club has its own rules on pricing, dress code and other regulations, all of which are too lengthy to print here. Our golf professionals will have a matrix at the counter showing each club's prices and dress codes, so you may cover that information when you call in to the Lochland Golf Shop to make your tee time.

This is a wonderful opportunity for Lochland members to get out and see other courses, we ask that you please be respectful of the other facilities' rules and regulations. We certainly do not want to wear out our welcome at the courses who are offering us the opportunity to enjoy their services.
